Nature Camp Scholarship Guidelines

Download this fillable pdf onto your computer, complete the next page, and submit via email as an attachment. Or, print it out to complete on paper and submit via U.S. Mail.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Applicants must be eligible to attend a summer session of Nature Camp (completing grade 5 through 12).
- Preference is given to residents of Augusta County, Staunton, or Waynesboro, but other applicants will be considered at the sole discretion of the Augusta Bird Club.
- The ABC Nature Camp Scholarship deadline (December 15) is before registration opens for Nature Camp. Scholarship winners must be accepted into Nature Camp before the scholarship can be awarded.

Process:

- Submit a completed ABC Nature Camp Scholarship application by the deadline, December 15. A complete application includes:
 - The Application Form.
 - A reference from an unrelated teacher.
 - An essay no longer than 75 words on the topic identified on the Bird Club's website, augustabirdclub.org.
- Partial or incomplete applications may not be considered.
- Candidates may be asked to participate in an interview.
- Scholarship recipients and amounts awarded will be at the sole discretion of the ABC Education Committee and the Board of Directors. The decision is final and not subject to review or appeal.
